PASTOR'S NOTES

We have all been deeply affected by the pictures and narrative stories coming from Haiti. The sight of such suffering moves even the hardest of hearts. Such tragedies test the will of the world to respond. The Christian asks the ultimate question: "What would Christ have me do?" Even if the answer to that question is not clear, we can pray. We can find ways to share from our bounty to the needs of others. Now there are definite needs right here in Caldwell County. As I write this, three of our members are down stairs helping people through our fuel fund. We have a group from the Love Fund which will be helping some in our own church family. The Dental Bus ministry has expanded to help persons between the visits of the Bus. Our church has responded generously over and over. Then we are moved by the plight of people who live in a different culture, but yet are part of God's creation.

There will be scams and corrupt people here and in Haiti who will take advantage of other's suffering and the compassion and generosity of caring people. That challenges us to find those groups that will be faithful with our gifts. We will re-

ceive funds through our church which will be forwarded to agencies we have used before. You can make a check to the First Baptist Church and mark it Haiti Relief. You may further designate your gift to go the International Mission Board of the Southern Baptist Convention which has missionaries in Haiti coordinating relief and medical mission efforts. Or you can designate the money to be sent through the N.C. Baptist Men who have a medical team already in Haiti and will be planning long term relief efforts. Both these agencies will send all of the money for Haiti to projects for these people.

We pray for the many needs in Caldwell County. We pray for the suffering in our own country. We pray for the needs of the people of Haiti. As the lawyer asked Jesus..."Who is my neighbor?"
