## **PASTOR'S NOTES**

This Sunday we begin our Deacon Nomination and Election Process. During our morning worship, each church member present will nominate seven persons from the list of those eligible. The nominations will be tabulated by the six outgoing deacons. Then on Sunday, November 15<sup>th</sup>, each church member present will vote for seven persons on the list of the fourteen persons who received the highest number of nominations on November 1.

We normally nominate and vote for six persons. This year we have a one year, unexpired term due to Sharon Barlow's moving to Greensboro. The procedure is that the six persons who have the highest number of votes on November 15 will be elected to four year terms of service. The person receiving the seventh highest number of votes will fill the one year term made vacant by Sharon's moving.

Our budget is formulated through a process that begins in August and concludes in December. The committees of the church have submitted their requests and these have been compiled by the Budget and Finance Committee. This proposed budget has been reviewed by

the deacons and will be available for discussion on Wednesday night, November 4. After our members have had opportunity to make commitments for the upcoming year, the budget will once again be reviewed by the deacons with a final recommendation for church adoption on Wednesday night, December 16.
