Kappy 132nd Birthday First Baplist

On August 15th, we will observe the church's 132nd birthday. We will look back with thanksgiving, but we will also focus on God's next challenge for the church. In the coming year, we will seek God's guidance on ministering to some of the needs closest to us. From our front steps...going down Mulberry and Main Streets and within a few blocks to the sides, there are 27 institutions which exist to protect, heal, enhance, feed, and provide guidance. How can we partner with some of these agencies? We are already partnering with some, but are there others. We will need mission teams from our church to be involved in education and involving our church. Many of our members will be asked. We will also need a mission fund to help finance projects that we discover.
