Hello friends,

Soon and very soon, the temperatures will cool off and the colors of Fall will emerge. This is my favorite time of year, for here in the foothills, we get to see God's creation at its best. With that said, please make sure that you are prepared for all the events that will take place this month. We will be busy, and my prayer is that our times of worship and service will be meaningful.

As part of our worship service on October 1st, we will celebrate World Communion Sunday. That means that during the worship time, we will join with millions of other Christians from around the alobe remembering Jesus' sacrifice on the cross. As we take the bread and the cup, may we recognize that we are not our own; we were bought for a price. Furthermore, we must understand that Jesus' sacrifice was not just for us, but for all people.
